

TRUSTEE REPORT NOV. 18, 2018

The Trustees met on Nov.11, 2018.

DynaMark has been informed to connect the kitchen range fire system to the building alarm system. Waiting to hear from them.

The Trustees and Pastor are collaborating on a letter to the children of Virginia Wehrli concerning her mention of RUMC in her will.

The special requests for donations to pay for painting the interior of the FH windows this winter has been successful. The Trustees will be asking for more donations in the spring for painting the outside.

There are new stains in the ceiling tiles in the Narthex. GOM's will try to see if there are roof leaks in that section. The shingles are 30 years old and due for replacement.

The Trustees had considerable discussion on church security in light of recent national events. Should we lock doors during worship service? How about security cameras? Should we seek advice from local police?

The church heating system has exceeded the entire building maintenance budget for 2018 in making repairs. Presently, both boilers need attention and the fan in the entryway has failed. It is time to investigate replacement of the system. In 1997, the estimate to replace was \$17,000.

Our building is valued at \$1.2 million by the town of Vernon. It is 60 years old and needs much attention.
