Developments this Summer
Stan Culy

We have developed a support group consisting of Steve Yoder, myself, Jackie Abbott
From North Manchester UMC, and Wail and Ghoufran Allababidi, an energetic
couple from the Berlin Mosque who give unstintingly to the family.

Tutoring fund—bridge building between cultures (see Newsletter article and picture)
Received money from two churches beside our own: North Manchester UMC
and Trinity Lutheran her in Vernon. (see financial report)
We have had three new tutors
We went to the science museum
Let's call it an educational fund.

Warmly Welcomed in four places

Kindergarten open house for parents at Vance Village School

New translator a young man who is a sophomore in engineering
at Central Connecticut University named Wally

Met another Arabic speaking family with a kindergartner

YWCA—Aisha the mother has registered for ESL classes (English as a second
Language)

Familiar faces because Aisha had met the staff last year

They hired a new Arabic speaking staff person who already had made a
home visit to Aisha

Salvation Army Food Program

Although it had been four months since the last visit, Aisha and Mohamed
Were urged to come into the backroom where they could pick
more easily the foods the family could eat

Bureau of Rehabilitative Services with Helena Talarczyk

Since Mohamed, at 37 years old, has been living with a non-functioning
hip problem from birth, his mobility is limited; so this state agency
has decided they will help him find a job. If they find an opening
for him, they can contract with the employer an agreement where
they will pay his salary and give a modest stipend to the company.
Furthermore, they can provide a coach and do on-the-job-training.

Department of Social Services (DSS)

This state agency monitors the cash benefits given to refugees for up to two years.
They work through a program called Jobs First which is requiring that the wife, Aisha,
enter into an orientation program which will help lead her in a job search. She is being
helped by Nancy Latif, who runs a Refugee Advocacy Group. Nancy is a very friendly,
resourceful person who speaks Arabic and has been doing this work for over ten years.
